

## APARTMENTS DESCRIPTION

### Le Querce

The "le Querce" apartment can accommodate from 4 to 7 people. It is a large 100 square meter apartment on two floors connected by a special internal staircase made of hand-made brick. On the ground floor there is a large and spacious living room with dining table, sofa and fireplace, upstairs there are two bedrooms, each with their own bathroom. From the windows you enjoy a wonderful view of the oak forests and the surrounding fields. The main hand-carved stone door of the Majella - as is the fireplace - by an artisan according to the traditional motives of local stone work, opens out onto a reserved square where, on spring and summer days, guests can eat outdoors in the shade of two large olive trees. The rustic and tasteful furnishings of the rooms are composed of antique and traditional furniture and wooden furniture, wrought iron and ceramic, and perfectly harmonized with the atmosphere of the house and the surrounding environment.

### Gli Olivi

The "Olivi" apartment is a beautiful panoramic and sunny apartment overlooking a small olive grove and from whose windows the look can range up to the distant peaks of the Gran Sasso. From its windows exposed to the west, in beautiful days, the apartment is flooded by the warm afternoon light until sunset. Access is from the outside, from a small terrace accessed by a short and characteristic stone staircase. This terrace, for its panoramic view of the surrounding quiet, is particularly appreciated by artists and those who are prone to meditation. In the spring and summer it is particularly enjoyable in the evening, dine outdoors while enjoying the rhythms, the sounds, the mild and discreet odors of the countryside. The apartment of 50 square meters can accommodate 2 to 4 people: it has a double bedroom, a bathroom, a large living room with corner fireplace and a sofa (bed) and a beautiful and large masonry kitchen.

### I Ciliegi
