20'S Classic Room

This room offers a relaxing and romantic atmosphere, furnished in tones of grey and red and is a jewel for connoisseurs of the 1920-1930 decade. Of particular note are the cubist chest of drawers and bedside tables found in the Antique Fair in Trieste, the 1925 armchair of futurist inspiration coming from a doctor's practice, and the Fontana Arte bathroom accessories, as well as other gems that experts will certainly recognize. The room is equipped with satellite television, a safe-box, free mini bar, free Wi-Fi, air conditioning and heating, large bathroom with glass-sided shower unit, natural wood flooring, and splendid embroidered bed linen passed down through the family, hair dryer, towels, beach towels, and a courtesy kit.

50'S Suite

This elegant and spacious junior suite with a view over the park and the quiet surrounding countryside is inspired by the 50's design with the prevailing colours of orange and white. Worthy of note is the refined sideboard by Osvaldo Borsani for Tecno, the small desk by BBPR for Olivetti and the Boomerang armchairs for Fritz Hansen, as well as numerous accessories reflecting the owner's passion for Italian design. This room is equipped with a flat-screen television (no SAT), safe-box, free mini bar, free Wi-Fi, air conditioning and heating, large bathroom with glass-sided shower unit, natural wood flooring, and splendid embroidered bed linen passed down through the family, hair dryer, bathrobes, towels, beach towels, and a courtesy kit.

30'S Loft

This bright open space attic has a surface of 75 sqm, exposed ceiling beams, and is dedicated to those wishing to feel spoilt with nothing but the best. The prevailing colour is white with a magnificent Jugendstil sage-coloured majolica stove, in perfect working order, which separates the dining area – in Vienna Secession style – from the relaxation area with 1960 Marco Zanuso furniture. The prestigious 30's style bedroom is panelled with root wood and includes a king-size bed, recovered from an ancient building in Trieste. You will be surprised by the bathroom tiles, originally designed by Antonia Campi in 1959, which blend to form a modern and spacious bathroom.
